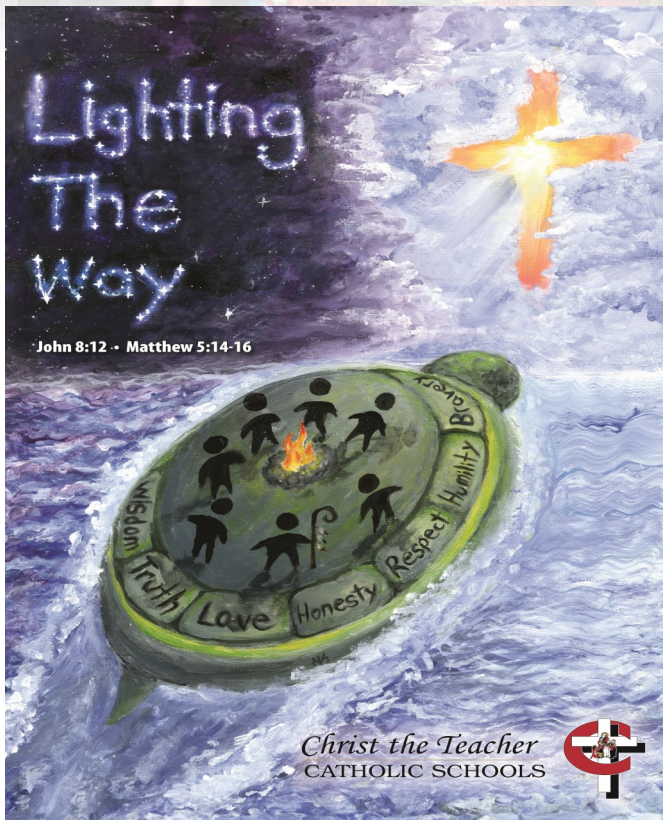

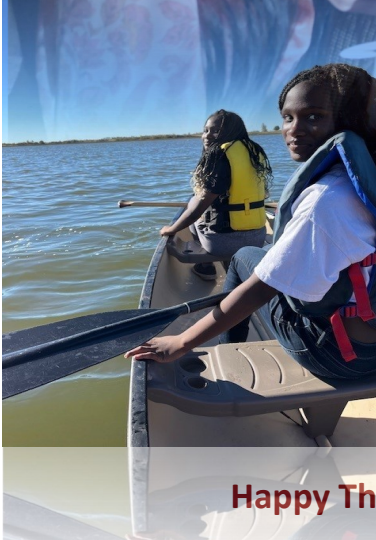


Agriculture in the Classroom
